Lehman, American conductor, organist, harpsichordist and composer, holds a Bachelor of Fine Arts degree in organ performance with honors from Carnegie-Mellon University, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, a Master of Music degree in church music from Westminster Choir College, Princeton, New Jersey, and earned his Doctorate from

the Graduate Theological Foundation of South Bend, Indiana. He has served on the staff of several distinguished churches, including the Washington National Cathedral, the Princeton University Chapel, and St. Bartholomew's Episcopal Church, New York City.

He joined the staff of the Church of St. Michael & St. George in St. Louis in 2008 and divides his time between Missouri, Connecticut, and New York with his wife and children. His compositions are published by several American publishers and have been recorded by leading choirs around the globe. His work is heard regularly over NPR and the BBC and he has been the recipient of many awards and honors.
